

Gonville & Caius June Event 2020

Frequently Asked Questions

When is the Gonville & Caius June Event?

Admission will begin at 20:00 on 16 June 2020. Last entry at 22:00.

How do I buy a ticket?

Tickets go on sale to Caians (including current students and alumni) and Fellows of Caius on Wednesday 12 February 2020 at 12:00 noon. Members of the University of Cambridge can purchase a ticket after their general release on Saturday 15th February 2020 at 12:00. Tickets are exclusively available online at www.caiusjuneevent.com

Am I guaranteed a ticket?

Sadly, we cannot guarantee tickets for all current Caians or alumni. Tickets are sold on a first-come, first-served basis. However, we do recommend joining the waiting list in case tickets become available due to cancellations.

Who can buy tickets?

Ticket buying priority is awarded to current members and alumni of Gonville & Caius College during the first ticket release. Members of the University of Cambridge will be able to purchase tickets during the secondary release. The status of all current students will be validated by Raven before the purchase of tickets.

How much are tickets?

For all current members of the College, tickets are priced at £87.50. For other members of the university, tickets are £92.50. Alumni tickets are £97.50.

How many guests can I purchase tickets for?

To give current Caius members a fair chance of getting a ticket, there will initially be a limit of two guests per primary ticket holder. Provided there are any remaining tickets, the primary ticket holder may choose to apply for an extra three tickets but this will be announced closer to the time.

Is there a waiting list?

There will be a waiting list in the event that the demand for tickets exceeds supply. Any ticket becoming available due to cancellation will be offered to a member of the waiting list. If this ticket offer is not accepted within 24 hours, it will be cancelled and offered to the next member.

How and when should I pay?

Payment details will be provided upon purchase of a ticket. Payment will be via bank transfer. If you do not have a UK bank account, please contact the Ticketing Officer, Hannah Obie, via ticketing@caiusjuneevent.com. You should pay within 5 days of purchasing a ticket, or it may be re-released.

I can no longer attend the Event – how do I cancel my ticket(s)?

Tickets can be cancelled free of charge and a full refund given up until the 1 March 2020. Thereafter, cancellations are subject to a £35 charge for a refund of the ticket price. From 9 May, tickets are non-refundable.

Can I change the name on my guest ticket?

Name changes to guest tickets will be free until 14 March, after which they will be charged at £10. From 10 May name changes will be charged at £35. It will not be possible to change the name on a guest ticket from 13 June.

When and where should I pick up tickets?

For your convenience and to reduce unnecessary waste, tickets for the Gonville & Caius June Event 2020 will be delivered by email on 14 June, a couple of days before the Event. If you have not received your tickets by 15 June, please contact the ticketing officer using the email below.
